## Calthorpe Academy Appeals Policy

### Introduction:

This policy addresses the situation where students may wish to appeal against a grade he/ she has received for a qualification.

### Access:

Students are made aware of the existence of this policy and have open access to it. It can be found in a folder in the SLT Office and online at <a href="https://www.calthorpe.bham.sch.uk">www.calthorpe.bham.sch.uk</a>. This policy is reviewed annually and may be amended in response to feedback from students, staff, parents and external organisations.

# Policy Statement:

All students at Calthorpe Academy have the right to make an appeal about any of the marks received for the qualifications they are undertaking.

If any student wishes to appeal a decision, they should follow the following procedure:

- 1. If possible, speak to a member of staff responsible for teaching the qualification in the first instance about the reason they wish to appeal
- 2. The member of staff has a responsibility to explain to the candidate why he/she received the grad/mark.
- 3. If the student is not satisfied with the explanation, the piece of work will be remarked by another member of staff also involved in that qualification
- 4. The student will be informed of the outcome of the re-marking by letter
- 5. If the student wants to continue to appeal, he/she needs to contact the exams officer, who will provide the student with information about the appeals procedure for the relevant awarding body on behalf of the student
- 6. Please note: a student must have the support of the centre to be able to appeal against a result.
